Dear Friends,

I have the pleasure to send you the following information concerning the organisation of the **FINA Artistic Swimming Development Webinar for Judges – Beginner Level** (Host Federation: SLO).

Please note the following information related to the development webinars for artistic swimming judges:

Course description

- The FINA Artistic Swimming Development Webinar for Judges Beginner level is equivalent to a FINA Artistic Swimming Development School for Judges – Beginner level.
- It takes place through the <u>FINA Learning Platform</u>, using the <u>Zoom</u> video conference tool
- It is only accessible to those candidates approved through the FINA GMS.
- The webinar consists of four half-day sessions and an online exam. Registered candidates must be able to fully attend and participate in all sessions.
- The official working language for the FINA Artistic Swimming Development Webinars is English.

Eligibility

- The FINA Artistic Swimming Development Webinar for Judges Beginner level is designed for those candidates with limited basic knowledge or no experience in judging.
- It is open to all the National Federations interested in developing judges that are not on the current FINA List.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old and not over 65 at the start of the FINA AS Development Webinar.

Registration

 Each FINA Artistic Swimming Development Webinar requires a minimum of 10 and may have a maximum of 15 participants.





Candidates must be registered through the FINA GMS by the established deadline.
Their profiles must include the following information: personal data, photo,
passport/National ID copy and the <u>candidate's personal email address</u>. Any application
without all the above-mentioned information will be rejected.

Approvals

- FINA will start to approve the registrations once the required number of participants has been reached (10).
- The approvals will be done on a <u>first come first served basis</u>, provided that the maximum number of participants (15) has not been reached.

Webinar access

- Each approved participant will receive access to the <u>FINA Learning Platform</u> after the registration deadline.
- The login details and the webinar's instructions will be sent to the candidate's email address as submitted in the registration.

Assessment

- A judge must score a minimum of 80% in order to pass a FINA Artistic Swimming Development Webinar – Beginner level.
- Once a participant has passed the online exam, he/she will be able to download a certificate. This certificate is equivalent to the one obtained after passing a FINA Artistic Swimming Development School – Beginner level.
